Bring the family to check out our interactive exhibits, including Pause Play, which invites you to hit pause on your busy lives and recapture the nostalgia of play.


You can also join the Fleet Science Center for Don't Try this at Home! shows in the municipal gym.


Explore the San Diego Museum of Art for free during December Nights! Enter at the west side of the plaza near Panama 66 for food and drinks.


Institute of Contemporary Art, San Diego (ICA San Diego)

Glittering gems, swirls of colors, elaborate filigree, whimsical designs – it's the Jewels of the Season: Holidays at the Timken an annual tradition since 1988 featuring a collection of ornaments designed and handcrafted by local artists Florence Hord and Elizabeth Schlappi. Each ornament features semi-precious gems, sequins, stones and filigree collected by the two artists from around the world. Often compared to Fabergé eggs, over 1,000 ornaments are on display in the museum's foyer and grand holiday tree.
