

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Nighttime Construction on Friars Road on Jan. 2 & Jan. 3

Dec. 30, 2024

On January 2 and January 3, construction crews will be working during the nighttime on Friars Road for the City of San Diego Morena Pump Station project, part of the Pure Water San Diego Program.

What To Expect: During nighttime construction, crews will be working on the west end of Friars Road, from the MTS Trolley overpass to Sea World Drive. Noise and light impacts are expected in the area, however; crews are aware of nearby residences and will minimize impacts to the extent possible.

When: The nighttime construction on Friars Road will occur on January 2 and January 3 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. each night. Please note that construction schedules are subject to change due to weather impacts, site conditions and operational issues.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply. The Morena Pump Station project is one of several major water infrastructure projects that are part of Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on morena.purewatersd.org.
