Victim Identified in Oak Park Independent Living Facility Shooting

San Diego – A 49-year-old man was found inside an Oak Park Independent Living Facility with a gunshot wound to his torso. Officers rendered aid to the man and medics transported him to a nearby hospital, but he did not survive the injury.

On December 21, 2024, at about 10:24p.m., officers from San Diego Police Department's Southeastern Division responded to an independent living facility (ILF) regarding a report of a person who had been shot. (This was initially reported at the 22nd.) The ILF, located at 3133 54th Street in the city of San Diego, is in the Oak Park neighborhood near Redwood Street. Once on scene officers located the victim, described as a 49-year-old black man, with a single gunshot wound to his torso. The victim has been identified as Dennis Robinson of San Diego. Officers performed CPR on Robinson until medics took over and transported him to a nearby hospital but unfortunately, he did not survive the injury.

At least nine people were inside the facility at the time of the incident and detectives are working towards interviewing them all and identifying exactly where the shooting took place. Investigators will be collecting and reviewing security video from the area. Thus far, there is no suspect description to provide.
