CITY HALL UPDATES

Proposed Affordable Housing Preservation Ordinance Coming Soon to City Council

On November 21st, 2024, the Land Use & Housing Committee (LU&H) unanimously approved the San Diego Housing Commission's (SDHC) proposed parameters for a local ordinance which would expand the opportunities granted under existing state law deed-restricted affordable housing and increase housing opportunities for very low, low-, and moderate-income households.

The LU&H Committee voted to advance the Preservation Ordinance to the City Council and will be discussed soon.

Tijuana River Valley Letter to President Biden

Last month, I held a press conference in City Hall alongside my colleagues to speak on the issue of the Tijuana River Valley sewage crisis. Later that day, the San Diego City Council unanimously approved my resolution.

Mayor Todd Gloria and City Clerk Diana Fuentes joined me in signing our resolution that the City Council unanimously approved urging the federal government to enact a national emergency for the Tijuana River Valley sewage and pollution crisis to fully fund the EPA's Comprehensive Infrastructure Solution for the Tijuana River Valley.

Shortly after, my office wrote a letter to President Joe Biden urging him to take the necessary steps to enact a national emergency regarding this environmental disaster.
