

Recreation Councils required to obtain non-profit status to continue collecting revenue at recreation centers

Interim SOP issued to all Community
Recreation Groups (CRGs). Working
Group of citizens formed by City
Council to provide input on updates
to CP700-42. Recreation Center
Funds were established to continue
funding programs

CP600-24 updated to meet legal requirements.
Internal comparison of CP600-24 and draft CP700-42 begins
