

Next Phase of Traffic Control on Clairemont Drive



On Thursday, Jan. 30, crews will install the next phase of traffic control on Clairemont Drive. This phase will accommodate pipeline installation work between Joplin Avenue and Clairemont Mesa Boulevard, which is expected to last approximately 6 weeks. Crews will be moving northbound on Clairemont Drive as they progress. All directions of travel will be open through the Clairemont Drive and Clairemont Mesa Boulevard intersection throughout this work.

Pipeline installation will take place between 7 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. Welding and other work to finalize the pipeline installation will take place between 4:30 p.m. and 11 p.m.

Access to driveways throughout the closure will remain open. For your safety, please follow all posted signage and plan extra time when traveling in the area to accommodate for traffic delays. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.
