

Paving on Clairemont Drive Between Erie Street and Iroquois Avenue

January 30, 2025

Starting Monday, February 3, crews will be paving Clairemont Drive during daytime hours between Erie Street and Iroquois Avenue. This work will be done in two stages, and will last approximately one week in total. During the paving operation, one lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained on Clairemont Drive.

Please see the two maps below outlining how the work will be done in two stages.

Access to driveways throughout the closure will remain open. For your safety, please follow all posted signage and plan extra time when traveling in the area to accommodate for traffic delays. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

During stage 1, crews will pave the outside lanes of Clairemont Drive, and one lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained between the work zones.



During stage 2, crews will pave the inside lanes of Clairemont Drive, and one lane of traffic in each direction will be maintained on either side of the work zone.
