Arrest made in Lincoln Park Homicide

San Diego – On Sunday, January 5, 2025, at about 9:36 a.m., officers from the San Diego Police Department’s Southeastern Division responded to a shooting in the area of 300 Willie James Jones Avenue. Once on scene, officers located a man in the street suffering from at least one gunshot wound to the torso. That man is now identified as David Solis, a 19-year-old man from Tijuana, Mexico. Officers administered first aid and medics transported Solis to a local hospital, but he did not survive his injuries.

Based on the investigation thus far, it appears that two men were in the area of 300 Willie James Jones Avenue spray painting gang graffiti on a wall. They were subsequently involved in an altercation with Solis, during which Solis was shot. Investigators identified one of these men as Edwin Aguayo, described as a 21-year-old Hispanic male. On January 7, 2025, at about 10:42 p.m., investigators located Aguayo in a vehicle in the area of I-5 and Del Mar Heights Road and arrested him for the shooting.

The second suspect is still outstanding, and the investigation is ongoing.
