Item 1: 0	Call to Order ((Chair Evans)
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- Meeting was called to order at 8:39 AM.
- Item 2: Action: Roll Call (Chair Evans)
 - In attendance: Ania Kaminska, Austin Evans, Brandon S. Johnson, Donna Deberry, Jenna Hanson, Juliet Terramin, Natasha Salgado, and Sarah Mattinson.
 - City Staff: Chief Scott Wahl, Lyndsay Winkley, Elizabeth Studebaker, and Alex Southard.

Item 3: Conversation with Chief Scott Wahl, San Diego Police Department

- Chief Wahl discussed various topics impacting small businesses such as safety and response.
- Top priorities include building trust and developing the workforce.
- Internal reorganizing helps with efficiency. Civilian staff who are experts in their field were hired including Lindsey Winkley as the Community Liaison Program Manager.
- Quality of life issues and the sense of feeling safe is also a priority.
- Addressing issues of homelessness through a centralized homelessness response. A progressive approach includes a warning, ticket, misdemeanor, and/or custodial arrest.
- The board asked questions and conversation followed.

- Item 4: Conversation with Community Liaison Manager, Lyndsay Winkley, San Diego Police Department
 - Lyndsay Winkley spoke about the work taking place within communities.
 - With over 12 years of experience covering the Police department, Lyndsay focuses highly on engagement and how the public can be involved/aware.
 - Communication upwards and breaking communication barriers is a priority.
- Item 5: Action: Approval of September 24, 2024 Minutes (Chair Evans)
 - With a motion by Sarah Mattinson and a second by Natasha Salgado, the Board voted to approve the September 24, 2024 minutes.

- Item 6: Discussion: San Ysidro Business Improvement District Advisory Committee (Liaison Southard)
 - Alex Southard shared an update on the San Ysidro BID activities.
 - The Advisory Committee had a San Ysidro Community Parking District presentation.
 - Banners were installed within the BID in mid-October.
 - A working group was formed that will focus on the future BID management.
 - The Board voted to appoint Carol Kang to the San Ysidro BID Advisory Committee.

 - Many coastal businesses are unsure how to approach the parking replacement requirement.
 - Discussion regarding the current state of the program and how the board can support through an advisory letter.

- The Capacity Building Grant program received almost twice as many applications compared to prior years. The goal is to soon begin contracting with awarded organizations.
- The Development Services Department provides a Small Business and Restaurant Assistance Program to help qualified small businesses with their planning and permitting needs. <u>Virtual appointments</u> are available.

• Assembly Bill 413, also known as Daylighting, is a California law that prohibits parking within 20 feet of any crosswalk, marked or unmarked, to improve visibility for drivers and pedestrians. More information visit the City's <u>website</u>.
