

December Public Realm Recap


- Park locations in proximity to higher density

- Utilize parking lots and street ROW for parks / plaza
- Create a comprehensive urban open space system






Urban Forest + Urban Greening

Park, Richmond, Upas & Spruce








Urban Corridor: 15'-25'




