- Nonprofits within the Promise Zone may qualify for grant preferences for certain competitive Federal grants.
- Small business within the Promise Zone may qualify for additional incentives within the City.
- Over 80 partners are committed to the Promise Zone mission, many are part of a working group such as Healthy Communities or Economic Activities.
