

## CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Friars Road 24-hour Closure and Eastbound Lane Closure between Sea World Drive and Napa Street

Feb. 25, 2025

From Friday, February 28, at 9 p.m. to Saturday, March 1, at 9 p.m., Friars Road from Napa Street to Sea World Drive will be closed to all traffic for the City of San Diego Morena Pump Station project, part of the Pure Water San Diego Program. This temporary full closure is to implement a new traffic control measure and will be between the specified hours only.

At 9 p.m. on Saturday, March 1, the Friars Road westbound lane will reopen and the eastbound lane between Sea World Drive and Napa Street will be closed as crews perform ongoing work for the pump station's underground infrastructure. The eastbound lane closure will be in effect through Fall 2025. Construction activities on Friars Road are expected to continue through the end of 2025. The project team is evaluating alternative traffic control plans to implement as needed.

What To Expect:

During the full road closure, all traffic will be detoured so crews can implement a new traffic control measure. After the temporary full closure, the eastbound lane on Friars Road between Sea World Drive and Napa Street will be closed and the westbound lane will reopen. The posted detours for both the temporary full closure and eastbound closure are Sea World Drive, Tecolote Road, Morena Boulevard and Napa Street. Please follow all posted signage and crew member directions near the work zone, and expect delays in the area. **Please see page 2 for a detour map.** 

When:

The temporary full road closure will be in effect from Friday, February 28, at 9 p.m. to Saturday, March 1, at 9 p.m. The eastbound lane closure on Friars Road will start on Saturday, March 1, at 9 p.m. The eastbound closure will be in place through Fall 2025. Construction will be active on Friars Road through 2025. The project team is evaluating alternative traffic control plans to implement as needed. Project updates and construction notices regarding Friars Road will be posted on the project website and distributed via email and social media updates. Please note that construction schedules are subject to change.

Why:

Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will complete our water cycle and provide San Diego with a local water supply after its completion. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply. The Morena Pump Station project is one of several major infrastructure projects that are part of Phase 1 of Pure Water San Diego.

The City is committed to clear communication and providing up-to-date information about construction activities. Properties along the construction area will receive printed notices before work begins near their address, and construction notices will be regularly posted on <a href="mailto:morena.purewatersd.org">morena.purewatersd.org</a>.
