SAN DIEGO CITY CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION
LIABILITY CLAIMS REPRESENTATIVE I - 1042

DEFINITION:

Under general supervision, to perform the less difficult claims adjustments related to the City's public liability programs; and to perform related work.

*** EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:**

- Investigates, adjusts, and settles simple or routine and less difficult bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage claims filed against the City;
- Reviews minor accident and injury reports;
- Interviews and corresponds with claimants, witnesses, physicians, and attorneys;
- Approves and recommends denial of claims;
- Determines extent of the City's liability;
- Negotiates settlements;
- Prepares investigative reports;
- Represents the City in small claims actions;
- Assists in the preparation of cases for litigation;
- Handles projects related to the maintenance of the City's insurance portfolio;
- Conducts risk studies;
- Performs cost recovery and subrogation investigations;
- Performs other duties as assigned.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Please note: the minimum qualifications stated below are a guide for determining the education, training, experience, special skills, and/or license which may be required for employment in the class. These are re-evaluated each time the position is opened for recruitment.
