- ADA survey being performed on Mountain View Park and community garden cannot be installed until all ADA deficiencies corrected
- Maintenance updates
 - Futsal courts are done, but basketball courts are not yet
 - Goal is to reopen teen center restrooms concurrent with futsal and basketball courts
