## **SUMMARY**

## BACKGROUND

In 2021, the City Auditor's office investigated inequities in the Parks and Recreation Department's programming, focusing on historically underserved communities. The Performance Audit of Equity of Recreation Programming revealed five key findings and 16 recommendations, highlighting resource shortages that hinder a strategic, data-driven approach to assess and meet community needs. A major recommendation was for the Department to conduct a Community Recreation Needs Assessment to address these inequities citywide.

## **DISCUSSION**

In January 2025, the Parks and Recreation Department acquired Keen Independent Research for the first-ever Community Recreation Needs Assessment. Over the course of a year, this study team will assess programs, services, and facilities to evaluate how well we serve our diverse communities. This process includes virtual workshops, surveys, interviews, focus groups, and public meetings for community feedback and collaboration with local organizations to ensure broad engagement.
