### **SENIOR LIABILITY CLAIMS REPRESENTATIVE - 1044**

### **DEFINITION:**

Under direction, to perform the most difficult and complex claims adjustments related to the City's public liability programs; to lead the work of other professional public liability claims representatives; and to perform related work.

## \* EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

- Investigates, adjusts, and settles the most difficult, complex, and sensitive bodily injury, personal injury, and property damage claims filed against the City;
- Evaluates property damage and bodily injuries to determine extent of the City's liability:
- Estimates settlement value if City liability exists;
- Reviews accident and injury reports:
- Interviews and corresponds with claimants, witnesses, physicians, and attorneys;
- Approves or recommends denial of claims;
- Negotiates settlements;
- Prepares comprehensive investigative reports;
- Represents the City in small claims actions, mediations, and settlement conferences;
- Assists in the preparation of cases for litigation;
- Performs cost recovery investigations regarding injury to City personnel;
- Handles projects related to the maintenance of the City's insurance portfolio;
- Facilitates liability evaluations;
- Conducts risk studies and special projects;
- Maintains monetary reserves;
- Handles settlements within assigned monetary authority;
- Works with the City Attorney's Office regarding Liability Claims Administration Standards (PRISM);
- Performs cost recovery and subrogation investigations;
- Ensures adherence to insurer reporting guidelines;
- Leads the work of professionals and paraprofessionals;
- Coordinates training programs and large projects.
