PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Neighborhood Use Permit (NUP) for a 106 square feet (SF) addition at the rear of an existing commercial building with a previously conforming use. The project would address code violation, CE-0514346 to allow the construction of the accessible bathroom and unpermitted plumbing and electrical improvements. The 0.23-acre project site is located at 5096 Voltaire Street, zoned RM-2-4 (Residential Multiple-Unit) and designated as Medium Density Residential (15-29 dwelling units per acre) in the Ocean Beach Community Plan. The site is also located within the Coastal Height Limit Overlay Zone, Coastal Overlay Zone (Non-Appealable-2), Ocean Beach Cottage Emerging District, Parking Impact Overlay Zone (Beach and Coastal Impact), Residential Tandem, Transit Priority Area, 60-65 dB CNEL Airport Noise Contour, Airport Land Use Compatibility Overlay Zone (San Diego International Airport ((SDIA) and Naval Air Station (NAS) North Island), Airport Influence Area (SDIA Review Area 1 & NAS Review Area 2), Airport Approach Overlay Zone, and the Federal Aviation Administration Part 77 Noticing Area. LEGAL DESCRIPTION: Map 119, Lot 98 Block 14, APN 448-133-31-00.

STATEMENT SUPPORTING REASON FOR ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: The City of San Diego conducted an environmental review that determined the project would not have the potential for causing a significant effect on the environment. The project meets the criteria set forth in CEQA Section 15061 (b) (3). A project is exempt from CEQA if the activity is covered by the common sense exemption that CEQA applies only to projects which have the potential for causing a significant

effect on the environment. A project is also exempt from CEQA where it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment. Since the project is an addition to an existing commercial site with previously conforming uses and would be within an existing structure on a developed site the project would not have a significant effect on the environment this exemption is deemed appropriate for this project. The site is included on list compiled pursuant to Government Code Section 65962.5 for hazardous waste sites.

The appeal filing fee must be United States Postal Service (USPS) postmarked) before or on the final date of the appeal. Please include the project number on the memo line of the check.
