

LIBRARY HOTSPOT LENDING PROGRAM UPDATE – APRIL 2025

What is the Library Hotspot Lending Program?

As part of the City of San Diego's Access 4 All initiative, the Library Hotspot Lending Program provides mobile Wi-Fi hotspots for San Diego Public Library (SDPL) patrons to check out and use no-cost internet access for up to three months at a time.

From **April 1 – June 30, 2025**, the Library Hotspot Lending Program will be temporarily paused to reconfigure or replace all hotspot devices currently in circulation. This process is necessary to ensure all devices meet federal E-Rate program requirements. Hotspot lending will resume on **July 1, 2025**.

What is the Federal E-Rate Program?

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) created the E-Rate program to provide discounts and reimbursements that make telecommunications and information services — including the Library Hotspot Lending Program — more affordable for schools and libraries. In addition to helping institutions provide no-cost internet access to their communities, E-Rate funding can provide program funding sustainability.

How will upgrades affect mobile Wi-Fi hotspots?

During the pause, SDPL will collect and deliver all compatible hotspot devices to the service provider (AT&T), who will upgrade devices and work to enhance device security and overall user experience. These enhancements are designed to foster a safer and more responsible browsing experience, meeting diverse needs while prioritizing privacy and user choice.

Internet Access Resources

Free Public Wi-Fi will continue to be accessible at all library branches and at over 300 sites across the city. Residents can find their nearest location at sandiego.gov/sdaccess. Library staff are available to offer additional information upon request.
