CONTRACTUAL VS RENTAL PROGRAM

The Carmel Valley Recreation Center offers a variety of programs for the youth which are provided through the means of two different sources: Contractual programs and Rental programs. Contractual programs consist of independent contractors that have been approved by the City of San Diego as a sponsored program. Rental programs are commercial companies that rent out the facility to offer their programs and activities for the community.

Requirements for Independent Contractors:

- All contractors, sub-contractors and volunteers must be fingerprinted through the City of San Diego Live Scan
- City staff handles all registration for the program
- Contractors must submit a business license and proof of insurance
- Contractors must provide Worker's compensation coverage for all their Employees

Requirements for Permit Holders/Rental Programs:

Must provide proof of insurance Must provide own advertisement for program

Handles all registration for their programs Rental programs are NOT required to submit proof of fingerprinting for their coaches, volunteers and/or

instructors.

Cash or paper check is not accepted for registration.

A **\$25.00** fee will be charged for declined electronic checks. All customers must verify that bank routing and account numbers are entered correctly.

All fees must be paid in full prior to attending the first class.

Classes not meeting the minimum number of students may be cancelled.

PROCESSING FEES ARE INCLUDED

All registration and reservation fees include a non-refundable 3% processing fee.

RECREATIONAL PROGRAMS REFUND AND TRANSFER POLICY

Written refund applications must be submitted, using the Application for Miscellaneous Refund Form (COM-6), in person at the facility where the program occurs. Refunds will be processed in accordance with the following policy:

97% refund - 10 or more calendar days prior to the first scheduled game

50% refund - less than 10 calendar days prior to the first scheduled game

No refund or transfer for requests after the first scheduled game

CINEMATOGRAPHY



"Picture Perfect, Point, Click and Shoot"

<u>Cinematography 101 (Ages 7 - 12)</u>

This course is an introduction to video scene setups and digital photography. Students will explore the importance of camera angles, shot sizes, and movements while grasping the basics of Go-Pros, gimbals and DJI drones. Students will discover the aesthetics of visual arts by telling a story through still-image and short scenes. Participants create a digital, non-narrative work portfolio by learning key cinematography concepts, including composition, lighting, color, and framing. Digital cameras and all equipment will be provided for course use.

- Parent or legal guardian must accompany children under 12 years
- The only devices allowed in a skate park facility are skateboards, roller-skates, roller-blades, and in-line skates. Any other devices, including but not limited to bicycles, scooters, and motorized vehicles are unlawful to use in a skate park facility.
- Skaters must be in full safety equipment to enter: Helmets, Elbow and Knee Pads designed for skateboarding
- Visitors/Spectators not skating are required to remain outside fenced area
- No smoking, alcohol, food or drink, or glass containers allowed inside the skate park
- Littering and graffiti are not permitted
