Just Call is an automated citizen information system designed to provide you with pre-recorded answers to the most frequently asked questions about City of San Diego services and programs 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

You'll find information about important community resources such as the City's parks and libraries, programs ranging from recycling to fire and crime prevention, activities and meetings, and certain non-City programs of interest to many residents and visitors.

Need to someone in person? For general San Diego City Government information or telephone numbers, you can call the City Information Center at (619) 236-5555 from 8 a.m.–5 p.m. Mon.–Fri., except legal holidays.

How to Use *Just Call*

- Have a pen or a pencil and notepaper handy to write down information.
- From a **touch tone** telephone call the *Just Call* service and enter the 3-digit code for any of the messages listed in this brochure.
- You may enter a code at any time.
- To hear another message, just press the desired code whenever you're ready.
- You may listen to up to four messages per call.
