Concerns: Usage of lanes between buses and cars. Street lighting. NH CPC has not heard this but will be affected. Traffic signals. Space on Park south of University.
- **B.** Jefferson Elementary Project. Proposed street vacation and new building addition. David Grant, presenter. Heard at UD/PR as info and at PF as action regarding vacation of Gunn Street between 28th and Utah. Creates joint use field with city. Will demolish one building and rebuild. Item will go to UD/PR for action. Concerns: Loss of parking. Parking in red zone on 28th St., possibly opening up during non-school hours. Fencing, kind and cost.
