To Whom It May Concern:

The North Park Planning Committee (NPPC) would like to express our support for North Park Main Street's (NPMS) Cal Trans Sustainability Grant to study and to create a plan that addresses deficiencies within the community and serves to strengthen connectivity between residential, business and schools .

This project includes an Infrastructure Study to consider a Safe Routes to School, a feasibility study of sidewalk improvements, traffic calming and speed reduction improvements; pedestrian and bicycle crossing improvements; on-street facilities; off- street facilities; secure bicycle parking facilities and traffic diversion improvements in the area connecting the North Park business district, the residential district and the two local elementary schools in the study area.

The study would also include a significant outreach component with public workshops conducted to gather data, collect ideas and provide opportunity to involve the community in the development of the plan.

The NPPC urges Cal Trans to fund the NPMS Grant application, which the NPPC believes would address and mitigate the challenges of a complex, urban environment that is seen as unsafe by parents and the community in general.
