# Minutes of the June 22, 2015 Meeting

#### Approval of Draft Agenda:

- Dunlop Street Apartments: Planning Commission review on June 25<sup>th</sup>.

## **Committee Reports & Updates:**

- Landscape Maintenance Assessment District (MAD): T. Rocha waiting for response on the watering of the trees in the median.
- **Traffic:** D. Beckham no report.
- Graffiti: J. Pinzini reduction in graffiti due to monitoring and repainting every week.
- Transportation: J. Pinzini Presentation on Ulric & Tate bus stop.
- Zoning & Land Use: M. Castro/T. Cleary Dunlop Street Apartments public hearing and project update.
  LVPG approved with 4 suggested conditions, none of them are included in final staff recommendations.
  T. Cleary (question to board): Does the LVPG believe there is concern about this project regarding pedestrian access to the alley? All board members agreed there are concerns. The chair will contact Planning Commission staff with these concerns.
  - M. Castro Hyatt Street, street width and traffic issues. LVPG is on record in support of Hyatt Street being converted to a one-way street. A petition is being circulated and will be submitted to the city.
- Morena Blvd Ad Hoc Committee: R. Bussell attended Clairemont Town Council's ad hoc committee
  meeting to observe. Ad Hoc committee members (LVPG) are not finalized yet, as are needed prepping
  materials and potential meeting location(s).

#### **Representative Committees:**

- o Community Planners Committee: J.Pinzini Trolley Station naming and short term rentals.
- o Linda Vista Recreation Council: D. Beckham Skate park name "Linda Vista Skate Board Park".

#### **Information Items:**

1) Update from Bayside Community Center: Corey Pahanish, Executive Director reported on the working partnership with USD to educate local residents on various community issues. He also covered a development proposal on the San Diego Unified School District's Revere Center property.

#### **Action Items:**

- 1) Verizon Comstock (#391457): Shelley Kilborn from PlanCom presented a project located on the property of the Linda Vista Presbyterian Church at 2130 Ulric Street. Wireless communication facility consisting of a new 40' tall architectural tower concealing 12 panel antennas and microwave dish with equipment located inside the base of the tower. An associated emergency generator will be located in an adjacent 160 sq. ft. enclosure.
- **2)** Langmuir Street Storm Drain Replacement (#391556): Process CIP-2 (WBS # B-12091.02.06) proposes to replace and install 326 LF of RCP storm drains at two locations: 2308 Langmuir Street: replace 83 LF and 6264 Osler Street: replace 120 LF of storm drain. Project includes construction of new clean outs, cutoff walls, energy dissipaters, rip rap pads. Item was tabled to next meet so city staff can attend and speak.
- **3) AT&T Mobility Kearny Mesa Park:** This agenda item was tabled to a future meeting at the request of the applicant.

## Suggested Items for Next Month's Agenda:

- Mesa/Chevron: Conditional Use Permit on July agenda.
- AT&T Mobility Kearny Mesa Park (#379729) tabled from June 2015 meeting likely to August.
