
IDENTITY THEFT SUSPECTS SOUGHT

(San Diego) The San Diego Police Department Financial Crimes detectives need assistance from the public in locating two identity theft suspects who fraudulently obtained nearly \$14 thousand dollars in loans. Photos of the suspects can be found on page two of this news release.

The first suspect is Darius Dwan Johnson, a black male, 26, 5'8" 190 lbs. with black hair and brown eyes. The second suspect is Taron Maurice Dunn, II, a black male, 18, 5'9" 130 lbs. with black hair and brown eyes. Both suspects may be in the San Diego area although Johnson made statements that he was moving to Henderson, Nevada. There are outstanding warrants for the arrest of these two suspects. Charges include identity theft (530.5 (a) PC) and grand theft.

Both suspects used the victim's identity to secure fraudulent loans through a local credit union. Detectives say the victim knows Johnson and the two suspects know each other. The victim is currently in the US Navy and Johnson was recently released from the Navy.
