I am reappointing Samantha Jenkins to the Citizens Advisory Board on Police and Community Relations.

Ms. Jenkins is an honorably served US Naval Veteran and first-generation Guyanese American, who is currently the Vice-Chair of the Citizens Advisory Board on Police and Community Relations (representing San Diego City Council District 4) and the Chair of the Skyline Paradise Hills Planning Group.

She is also a board member with the Black Women's Institute for Leadership Development (BWILD), the DEI Co-Chair of Women Give San Diego, University of San Diego Department of Leadership Studies DEI Steering Committee member, and a former member of the San Diego NAACP Executive Committee. A civic engagement advocate, Ms. Jenkins is a graduate student at the University of San Diego School of Leadership and Education Sciences (SOLES) and has worked for various local nonprofit organizations in both administrative and direct service roles in the service of children from low-income households, unsheltered persons, and veterans. She volunteers with local social justice and advocacy organizations, speaking to groups about the value of civic engagement among communities of concern. She will be serving a two-year term ending January 1, 2024.
