Victim identified in Homicide in Rancho Penasquitos

San Diego – On June 15, 2022, at approximately 8:24 a.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received a call from a concerned citizen regarding a female deceased in a condominium in the 9300 block of Twin Trails Drive. Officers from Northeastern Division and San Diego Fire Rescue personnel responded and arrived within minutes. Upon arriving, they located an obviously deceased female in the condominium and a male at the residence. Due to the female having signs of trauma to her upper body and the suspicious nature surrounding the death of the female, the male was detained and San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene to investigate.

It is early in the investigation and San Diego Police Homicide Detectives are still determining the circumstances surrounding the death of the female. What is known at this time is officers responded the evening before on a report of a disturbance at the location involving the male. Officers made numerous attempts to contact the male and any residents inside the apartment through various means of communication. However, they received no response and were not able to confirm a crime had occurred at that time and they cleared the area.

The deceased female has been identified as Nahal Connie Dadkhah. She is described as a 45-year-old Middle Eastern female and is a resident of San Diego.

Parrish Chambers Jr., described as a 43-year-old Black male resident of San Diego, was detained by officers at the scene. He was subsequently arrested and booked into jail for one count of murder.
