Naloxone (trade name “Narcan”) is a medication used as an antidote to reverse the effects of opiate overdoses. California legislation allows private persons and first responders to possess Naloxone and administer the antidote medication in cases of opiate overdoses.

The initial doses of Narcan that were issued to Department members are set to expire March 31, 2021. The County’s Health Department has provided the Department with replacement doses. Therefore, Department members who were issued Narcan that expires in March 2021, will need to return their doses to Operational Support **no later than March 19, 2021**, for an updated supply. The new doses are good until September 2023.
