Normal operating hours for the San Diego Police Range are as follows:

Sunday Closed

Monday 1300-2300 (No shooting after 2200)

Tuesday-Thursday 0700-2300 (No shooting before 0800, or after 2200) Friday 0700-1700 (No shooting before 0800, or after 1600)

Saturday Closed

Due to on-going construction, damage to the facility, and use of the facility by unauthorized personnel, **Department members are not to utilize the Police Range unless Range personnel are present and working.** With the current demands of qualifications, classes, training, and maintenance, the Range and Range staff are not always available during the above listed hours.

The West Range (next to the Central garage) will be the only range available for active shooting before 1600 hours. All Department shoots, Regional Academy classes, Advanced Officer Training, Two-Day Rifle Classes, squad training, HR 218 qualifications, and back-up / off-duty weapon qualifications will occur on this range while the East Range (Qualification Range) is under construction.

The West Range may be used for handgun and rifle practice, between regular Department shoots and other training classes, **by San Diego Police personnel only**. No other Law Enforcement agency personnel, friends, or family may utilize the range without express permission from the Rangemaster.

No weapons other than those authorized for use by the San Diego Police Department may be fired without express permission from the Rangemaster. Under no circumstances will steel-core ammunition, armor piercing ammunition, frangible slugs, tracer rounds, or other incendiary projectiles be fired at the Police Range.

The Rapid-Fire Ranges may be used for handgun and shotgun practice only starting at 1600 hours, Monday through Thursday. Department personnel are recommended to call the Range office at (619) 527-6070, or go to http://sdpdshare/lists/range%20schedule/calendar.aspx on the department intranet, for current hours of availability.

Trash, household waste or hazardous materials shall NOT be placed in the trash dumpsters. The Range is equipped with 24-hour video surveillance; personnel using the Range after hours, or disposing of items in the trash dumpsters, will receive appropriate discipline.
