Victim Identified in Lincoln Park Homicide

San Diego—On Monday, March 16, 2020, just after 6:30 p.m., the San Diego Police Department Communications Center received a 911 call regarding an injured male that had been transported to Paradise Valley Hospital.

Upon arriving at the location, officers were directed to a black male in his early 20's who had sustained apparent trauma to his upper body. The male was transported to another hospital where his injuries were determined to be life threatening.

Officers learned the male's injuries were related to an earlier incident at 5000 Logan Avenue. Due to the nature of his injuries, San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident.

Unfortunately, the male succumbed to his injuries. The victim has been identified as 21 year-old Timothy Stewart.

The suspect is described as a dark skinned male wearing dark clothing.
