



District Deviations Based on 2019 SANDAG Population Estimates

The following table is based on the 2019 SANDAG population estimates not the 2020 Census data used for redistricting. This table shows the degree to which the 2019 estimated population for each City Council district deviates from the ideal size of one-ninth of the total city population. It also shows how the population in each district has changed since 2010.
