I am writing in regard to a conference which I had with Mayor Harley Knox last Thursday, 17 April 1947. At that time I made the request that the field north of the Boys Club at 30th and Ocean View Boulevard be leased to Post No. 6 of the American Legion for the purpose of developing a baseball field, to be used primarily for Junior American Legion Baseball.

We in the Legion feel that our baseball program is a very worthy project and aids materially in solving the problem of juvenile delinquency.

Mayor Knox agreed with me and suggested that with the approval of the City Council the area above mentioned be leased to Post No. 6 of the American Legion for a period of ten years at \$1.00 per year.
